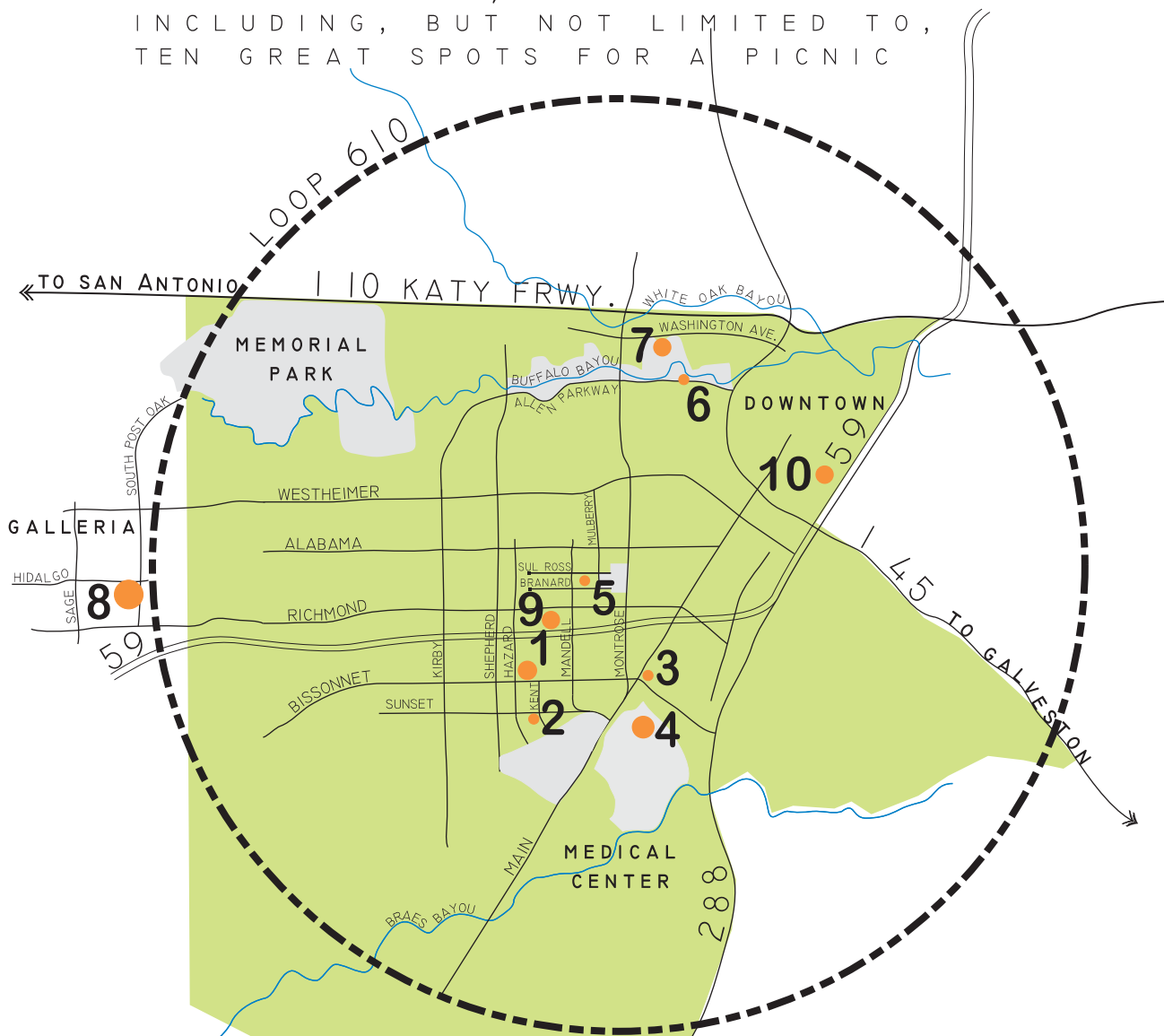

2. **Martha Fleming Park**  
 Southwest corner of Sunset and Kent. The neighborhood favorite!
3. **Cullen Sculpture Garden**  
 1000 Bissonnet at Montrose, across the street from the MFA. An urban retreat just down the street, the garden is dedicated to "artists who have shaped the course of sculpture in the 20th century." Louise Bourgeois, Alberto Giacometti and Frank Stella are some of the big names in this little garden. Architect: Noguchi, 1986
